



## ***Your Generosity Reaches Around the World***

In last month's newsletter the Team Leaders shared with you that the church met its budget obligations in 2010, which was a wonderful accomplishment. You are all to be commended for your commitment to the work of the church and the cause of Christ. As a result of the article, a number of you have asked what ministries we support with our money. Without being too lengthy, I would like to give you a brief synopsis of where our financial support goes, beyond the costs of our church facility and staff and program.

In 2010 we donated to the Brotherhood Fund, which supports the overall program of the Church of the Brethren, including outreach throughout the world. We contributed to the Atlantic Northeast District, Brethren Village, Bethany Theological Seminary, Elizabethtown College- Brethren Ministry, Camp Swatara, the Manheim Central Christian Ed Council, the Manheim Ministerium, the Disaster Relief Auction, the Water Street Rescue Mission, the Bowery Mission in New York City, COBYS, Teen Central, several missionaries, Love, Inc., the Alpha and Omega Family Ministry, local outreach in our immediate area, Susquehanna Valley Pregnancy Services, and support for ministry within the Lancaster County Prison. All of these ministries are listed in our church directory.

Beyond what I have just listed, our church also financially supported our blanket ministry, Campus Crusade for Christ, Monich Compere Missionary, Haiti Relief, the Mission to Unreached Peoples, and the Samaritans Purse. You were generous as well last fall when we were raising money for the Clean Water Program. You also gave generously to our church benevolence fund for church family members who have had specific needs.

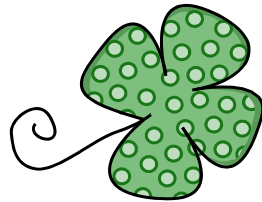

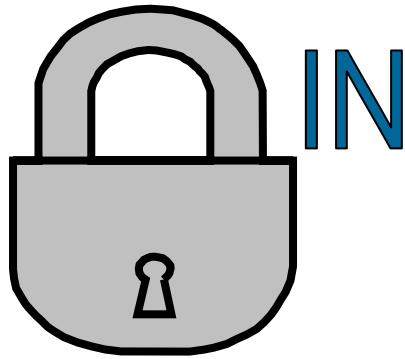
