Hand washing will again be offered for anyone that is unable to participate in foot washing. We hope to see everyone on

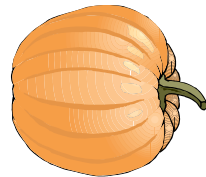

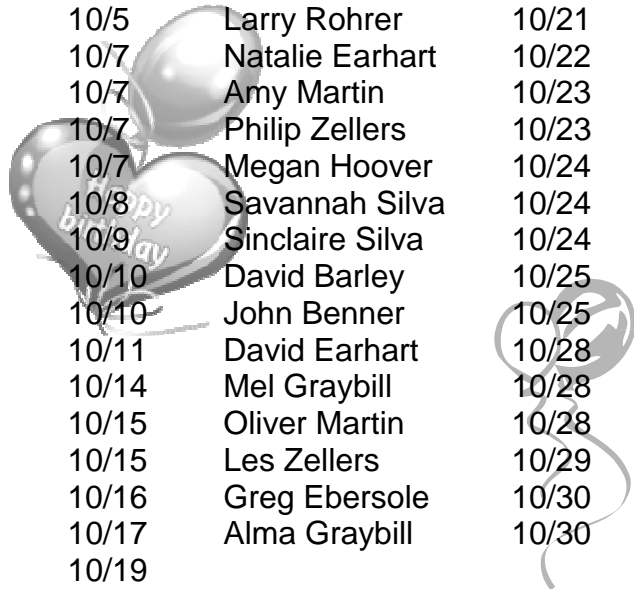

Special Response Hearing Schedule

When controversies arise in human relationships and within the church, it is important to take time to carefully and intentionally listen to God and to each other lest the matters at hand become adversarial and destructive. In 2009, the Church of the Brethren Annual Conference received a query and a statement as items of business related to homosexuality. That Conference identified these items as matters of such controversial nature that they referred them to a special response process previously approved for such matters. This process asks our districts to hold hearings during the coming year to (1) listen to each other and (2) share information for Standing Committee to prepare recommendations to the 2011 Annual Conference regarding these two business items.
